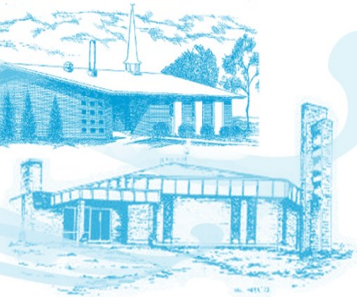

## Prayer for Fathers

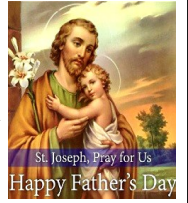
